FR. NIGEL MUMFORD



The Rev. Nigel Mumford was born and educated in England. He served for six and a half years in Her Majesty's Royal Marine Commandos.

In 2004, Fr. Nigel was called into the healing ministry of Christ the King Spiritual Life Center and in June 2005, he was ordained into the Priesthood of the Episcopal Church. Fr. Nigel's love for the healing ministry is expressed in his words, "Something always happens when we pray. Everyone is healed. Some are cured."

In his book After the Trauma. The Battle Begins/Post-Trauma Healing, he writes, "The mind is witness to a catastrophic event. It cannot cope with what it has seen. The body reacts physically under duress. The heart gets scar tissue, and the soul weeps. It is a total body experience."
